To ask the Chief Executive what can be done to protect access from Ashfield Avenue to surrounding fields as there needs to be a solution that protects the trees facing Ashfield Avenue whilst also providing no way of access to / from the field as antisocial behaviour is a big concern for residents in the field and subsequently in the Estate?"

Reply:

- The agriculture areas that the people are entering falls outside our remit as this falls under the Occupiers Liability Act and is an issue for the 3rd party landowner.
- All anti-social behaviour should be referred to the Gardai as they have the powers to deal with this.
